

SÃO PAULO – VIRACOPOS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT



São Paulo Viracopos International Airport, located in Campinas, 90 km north of São Paulo city and in São Paulo state, has experienced a huge increase in passenger traffic over the last seven years, reaching 10 million passengers in 2019. This increase is largely due to the installation of Azul, an airline formed in 2008, which chose Viracopos as its principal base and hub, mainly with domestic flights. Viracopos is also one of the most important airports for cargo traffic in South America, carrying an average of more than 230,000 tonnes a year.

The volume of traffic is forecast to reach more than 50 million passengers by 2042, which is when the current concession contract ends. In the coming years Viracopos International Airport will be connected to the economic centre of São Paulo by a high speed train link, increasing its importance as the second international airport of São Paulo state.
